Introduction to Metal Embossing

Saturday: July 24 1-4 p.m. 1 session \$50

Embossed metal is an increasingly popular medium for embellishing mixed media, collage, jewelry, scrapbooking, decorative home décor, and fiber art. The technique, itself, is an ancient art-form used to create relief work in metal. Similar to repoussé, but using simpler tools and thinner metal foils (copper, pewter, tin, aluminum, brass, silver); designs, dimension and texture are worked into the metal. In this hands-on class, you will learn about metal foils, sources of and methods to transfer designs, and basic metal-working techniques. As metal and the use of tools are included in the class fee, you can explore this medium without investing in more than the class.
